



GT-SAT Privacy Policy

This privacy policy will explain how our organization uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our services and/or our website.

What data do we collect?

Our Company collects the following data:

Services

The data recorded on the digital signage software is and remains the sole responsibility of the customer.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide GT-SAT with most of the data we collect.

We collect data and process data when you:

- You enter a commercial relationship for the provision of a digital signage service
- You fill in the contact page of our website

How will we use your data?

GT-SAT collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order and manage your account
- Provide you with the subscribed service (digital signage and helpdesk)

- Respond to your request via the contact page of our website

Your data is never transmitted to a third-party company.

How do we store your data?

Your data is recorded and stored in our secure management system hosted in a European datacenter.

These data are kept for a period of one year after the end of the commercial relationship. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data. However, this retention period may be extended in the context of legal proceedings.

Accounting and tax data are kept for a period of 10 years minimum as provided by law:

What are your data protection rights?

GT-SAT would like to make sure you are fully aware of all your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to access – You have the right to request GT-SAT for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- The right to rectification – You have the right to request that GT-SAT correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request GT-SAT to complete the information you believe is incomplete.
- The right to erasure – You have the right to request that GT-SAT erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that GT-SAT restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to GT-SAT's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to data portability – You have the right to request that GT-SAT transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
